CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE: 1: NAME, EMBLEM, UNIFORM, MOTTOS

SECTION 1-1: NAME

The name of this “Red Knights Chapter” shall be:

This Chapter shall be a not-for-profit social club.

SECTION 1-2: CHARTER

Chapters of the Red Knights International Firefighters Motorcycle Club® Inc. may be chartered only by the Red Knights International Motorcycle Club Corporation. The application to and approval by the Red Knights International Motorcycle Club Corporation for a Charter binds the Chapter to the International Rules and Regulations, SOGs and International Bylaws, as amended from time to time at the Annual Meetings of the Red Knights International Motorcycle Club Corporation. This Charter may be revoked by the International Executive Board for items that may include but not limited to; inappropriate conduct, arrears of Annual dues, failing to file annual rosters and reports.

SECTION 1-3: EMBLEM

The Emblem / Crest are set forth by the International Corporation and will not be altered in any way without the approval of the International Executive Board.

ARTICLE: 1: NAME, EMBLEM, and UNIFORM

SECTION 1-4: UNIFORM

The Chapter membership may adopt a uniform, jacket that is in good taste and worn in such a manner as to project a positive image of the Red Knights. The Chapter may adopt any color as long as they are the same and style. The vest / jacket color of this Chapter is black. The 10" (ten inch) Emblem / Crest, three (3) piece patch, or any part of it, may be affixed to the back of the Vest only.

SECTION 1-5: MOTTOS

The International motto is; "**LOYAL TO OUR DUTY**". This will also be adopted by the Chapter.

SECTION 1-6: MAILING / EMAIL ADDRESS

The Chapter mailing address and e-mail address of record will be that of the current Chapter President. All communications shall be forwarded to the proper Officer(s) or member. Communication to the International Executive Board shall be sent to the International Regional Director for distribution.

CHAPTER STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINES (SOG'S)

ARTICLE: 2: MEMBERSHIP, TENURE, OFFICERS, DUTIES, CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD and MEETINGS

SECTION 2-1: CLASSIFICATIONS

Membership classifications shall be consistent with membership classifications stated in the International Bylaws.

SECTION 2-2: MEMBER INFORMATION

All members shall keep the Chapter Secretary informed of current addresses, phone numbers, e-mail addresses, and any other pertinent information. At regular meetings, a member may be entitled to only one vote despite the multiple membership classifications they qualify for. All members may be appointed to Committees as needed. The Chapter Secretary shall immediately notify the International of any changes to the chapter roster and send the appropriate dues to International.

SECTION 2-2 A: ANNUAL CHAPTER MEETING PARTICIPATION

Participation at the Annual Meeting is strongly recommended, and is open to all membership categories. Any member participating must be in good standing at the time and date of the event. The caveat of *good standing* shall be defined as any member classification that has the member's dues paid for the current year, is not on suspension at the time of the meeting, and that membership requirements have been met and / or exceeded for the membership calendar year.

Participation outside the Chapter guidelines will invoke an "event cover charge of not less than \$35 per person and / or the cost per person food charge" for the individual and any guest(s) that are attending with such member.

ARTICLE: 2: MEMBERSHIP, TENURE, OFFICERS, DUTIES, CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD and MEETINGS

SECTION 2-3: ELECTED OFFICES

The elected Offices of this Chapter shall be; President (Chapter Representative), Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Road Captain, Quartermaster, the elected Officers of the Chapter shall be the Chapter Executive Board with the President serving as Chairman.

Other than the office of President and Vice President, one member may hold more than one office until such time that more members become available.

SECTION 2-4: ELECTIONS

The President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Road Captain and Quartermaster shall be elected each year at the Annual Meeting. Committee chairpersons and Committees will be appointed by the President on a yearly basis at the Annual Meeting.

SECTION 2-5: NOMINATIONS

Nominations for Officers shall be presented by the Nominating Committee at the normal meeting the month prior to the Annual Meeting. Nominations will be taken from the floor at the same meeting. Voting for Officers shall be by secret ballot at the Annual Meeting if two or more members are running for one office. After the election is completed, all ballots will be destroyed. In the event that all offices are classified as an unopposed ballot, then the Secretary shall cast a single vote to determine the election results.

SECTION 2-6: PRESIDENT

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Chapter, appoint Committees and non-elected officers. The President shall at all times, enforce a due consideration and observance of the International and Chapter Constitution, Bylaws and Rules and Regulations and shall preserve order and harmony within the Chapter. The President will be the Chapter Representative at International Meetings and State / Province Association Meetings. If the President cannot attend, the President will appoint another member in the President's place. The President shall report activities, problems, and Chapter Officer

ARTICLE: 2: MEMBERSHIP, TENURE, OFFICERS, DUTIES, CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD and MEETINGS

SECTION 2-6: PRESIDENT (continued)

Changes to the State Representative or Regional Director as needed. The President shall be ex-officio member on all Committees except the Nomination Committee. The President shall be shall be the co-signer with the Treasurer on notes, checks, and other legal documents unless other arrangements have been made. The President shall accept all gifts and donations on behalf of the Chapter.

SECTION 2-7: VICE PRESIDENT

The Vice President shall preside in absence of the President in case of disability or vacancy of office. The Vice President shall be responsible for money raising projects of the Chapter. The Vice President should be a co-signer on the Chapters checking / savings account in case the President is not available as the second signer with the Treasurer.

SECTION 2-8: SECRETARY

The Secretary shall attend all meetings when possible, keep records of all proceedings, keep a current roster of Chapter members, attend to all correspondence and keep the State / Province Representative and the International Secretary informed of Membership, Officers and activities. The Secretary shall render monthly reports in the form of newsletters or electronically to the Chapter Members, keeping the membership informed of all functions, activities and inform all members of the Constitution, Bylaws and Rules and Regulations amendments and / or changes. The Secretary may contract for supplies, printing, postage and other minor purchases to maintain the chapter at the Secretary's discretion, presenting bills to be paid for by the Treasurer with the membership approval at a stated meeting. All expenditures shall be registered and audited prior to the Annual Meeting. The Secretary shall, at the expiration of the Secretary's term of office, transfer all books, papers, monies and other Chapter property to the Secretary's successor in office.

ARTICLE: 2: MEMBERSHIP, TENURE, OFFICERS, DUTIES, CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD and MEETINGS

SECTION 2-9: TREASURER

The Treasurer shall attend all meetings when possible and pay all bills and vouchers when properly approved by the Chapter Executive Board and the membership, keeping a record of the same. The Treasurer shall be the principle signer of notes, checks and other legal documents along with the chapter president. The Treasurer shall end the year's finances on December 31st of any given year. The Treasurer shall open and maintain a checking / savings account in a federally insured Bank or Credit Union. The Treasurer shall collect all yearly dues and other monies, keeping records of all transactions.

The Treasurer shall give a report of the Chapters finances at regular meetings, giving copies to the Chapter Executive Board when requested. The books shall be made available for inspection to any member of the Chapter upon request.

The Treasurer shall coordinate with the Secretary so that all members receive their Annual dues cards and other necessary information. The Treasurer shall forward the Annual per-capita dues and current roster of all members to the Red Knights International Executive Board Treasurer on or before December 31st and no later then February 15th. The Chapter Treasurers books shall be audited by the Auditing and Finance Committee prior to the Chapter's Annual Meeting. At the expiration of the Treasurer's term of office, The Treasurer shall transfer all books, paper, monies and other Chapter property to the Treasurer's successor in office.

SECTION 2-10: ROAD CAPTAIN

The Road Captain shall be responsible for directing the movements of the Chapter while traveling together in a safe and lawful manner. The directions and orders of the Road Captain will be followed until such a time that any problems that may arise can be resolved. The Road Captain shall assist in setting up trips, checking the route for detours and hazards and make arrangements for rest stops, meals and meetings. Trips shall be

kept within reason i.e. miles, meals, dirt roads, times, etc. The Road Captain shall inform the Secretary of the proposed trips so the membership can be informed. The Road Captain shall lead the movements of a group and assign another experienced member to bring up the rear. The Road Captain shall create a ride schedule and take suggestions from the membership for trips and rides. The Road Captain shall inform new riders of Chapter riding procedures.

SECTION 2-11: OFFICER RESIGNATION

An Officer may resign at any time by giving written notice of such resignation to the Chapter President. The President may appoint an Officer, or if requested by the membership at a regularly scheduled meeting, the vacancy may be filled by nomination and vote of the membership present at such meeting to complete the term.

SECTION 2-12: OFFICER COMPENSATION

Officers shall not receive compensation for their services unless as noted herein or approved at the Annual Meeting.

SECTION 2-13: CONSENT OF THE CHAPTER

Officers and members shall not commit the Chapter to anything or anybody without the consent of the voting members present at any regularly scheduled meeting.

SECTION 2-14: EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETINGS

Executive Board meetings may be called at the will of the President at any time or place he wishes with one week's notice. Executive Board meetings should be open to all members unless it goes into Executive session.

ARTICLE: 2: MEMBERSHIP, TENURE, OFFICERS, DUTIES, CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD & MEETINGS

SECTION 2-15: MEETING AGENDA

The order of business at all meetings shall be as follows;

1. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.
2. Introduction of New Members and Guests.
3. Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting.
4. Treasurers report. Presentation of bills and payment.
5. Reading of correspondence and action taken.
6. Report of other Officers. (Quartermaster & Road Captains)
7. Committee reports.
8. Old Business
9. New Business.
10. 50 / 50 Drawing
11. Adjournment.

SECTION 2-16: REGULAR MEETING

The regular stated monthly meeting of this Chapter will be at 1900 hours on the fourth Thursday of the month unless otherwise announced. All members shall be notified by the Secretary of the date, time and place and activity at least one (1) week prior to the meeting. The January and February meetings may be put aside at the discretion of the Chapter Executive Board.

SECTION 2-17: ANNUAL MEETING

The Chapter's Annual Meeting shall be held in December as the membership wishes it to be scheduled. This shall be a special event of the Chapter. At the Annual Meeting, the election and installation of new officers will be held, Annual Officer's Reports and the yearly dues are payable to the Chapter Treasurer. The President will appoint all necessary Committees. All members and special guests shall be notified by the Chapter Secretary of the date, time and place at least one week prior to the Annual Meeting.

ARTICLE: 2: MEMBERSHIP, TENURE, OFFICERS, DUTIES, CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD and MEETINGS

SECTION 2-18: QUORUM

To conduct official Chapter business, a quorum of 50% Officers and four members are required at any Regular Meeting or Annual Meeting. A quorum of at least (51%) of the Members of the Chapter Executive Board is required at any Chapter Executive Board meetings. Minutes of all meetings shall be read to the Membership by the Chapter Secretary. If the Chapter Secretary is not present, the President may appoint some other qualified person.

SECTION 2-19: VOTING

At all meetings of the Chapter in which there is a quorum present, a Majority of the votes cast on any matter that comes before the membership shall control.

Any matter concerning SOG changes will require two-thirds vote for passage by those present at regularly scheduled meeting. A simple majority vote is needed to initially approve these SOG's.

SECTION 2-20: CHAPTER REPRESENTATIVE

When it becomes necessary to vote on International issues or International Constitution and Bylaws changes, a vote will be taken on the issue by the Chapter at a regularly scheduled meeting. The Chapter Representative will reflect that vote at the International Corporation Convention Annual Meeting. The Chapter Representative will have one vote on any International Matter.

SECTION 2-21: ABSENTEE OR PROXY VOTING

There shall be no voting by absentee or proxy at any meetings of the Chapter.

SECTION 2-22: GOVERNING RULES

Robert Rules of Order shall govern the conduct of all meetings unless inconsistent with the International and Chapter Constitution and Bylaws.

ARTICLE: 2: MEMBERSHIP, TENURE, OFFICERS, DUTIES, CHAPTER EXECUTIVE BOARD and MEETINGS

SECTION 2-23: COMMITTEES

The following Committees may be appointed by the President. Other committees as may be needed from time to time may also be appointed.

1. Bylaws Committee
2. Audit and Finance Committee
3. Nomination Committee
4. Entertainment Committee
5. Annual Fund-Raising Event Committee
6. Burn Camp Ride

CHAPTER MEMBERSHIP GUIDANCE

ARTICLE: 3: CONDUCT, APPLICATIONS

SECTION 3-1: CONDUCT

All members shall conduct themselves in a prescribed manner of our proud history of Firefighting and public servants. All members shall be accountable to the International and Chapter Constitution, Bylaws and Rules and Regulations. All members shall ride in a safe and lawful manner when moving in public and assist the public if possible without harm to yourself, your passenger and the Chapter.

No one shall be denied membership because of race, sex, religion, nationality, political affiliation or disability. Membership shall not be restricted to a class or manufacture of motorcycle as long as they are licensed and in a safe and working condition and street Legal.

SECTION 3-2: APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

All applications for membership shall be made upon the prescribed form and presented at a regular meeting, signed by the applicant giving their name, address, phone number etc., and shall be accompanied with the necessary fees and dues. A vote shall be taken upon every applicant for membership and shall receive two thirds (2/3) (66%) acceptance vote of members present with no probation period. A prospective applicant member must be present at the time of the vote. If an applicant is rejected, they may re apply in six (6) months. If rejected, the fees and dues will be returned.

SECTION 3-3: MEMBER SUSPENSION OR REMOVAL

Any member who has been found guilty of a felony or dismissed from the Fire service for conduct unbecoming a firefighter shall be dropped from the membership roster. Any member, who cheats, defrauds or steals from the Chapter may be suspended by the President or Vice President pending a majority vote of the membership present at a regularly scheduled meeting regarding the suspension and possible expulsion from the Red Knights.

ARTICLE: 3: CONDUCT, APPLICATIONS

SECTION 3-3: MEMBER SUSPENSION OR REMOVAL (continued)

Any member suspended may also face prosecution for any acts which are judged to be in violation of the law.

Any member suspended for six (6) months shall be terminated.

SECTION 3-4: FORMER MEMBER REAPPLICATION

Any former member, who was dropped from the roles due to conduct unbecoming a Firefighter, may reapply for membership as a new member according to Article 3; Section 3-2.

CHAPTER MONIES

ARTICLE: 4: CHAPTER DUES, FUNDS, CONTRIBUTIONS

SECTION 4-1: CHAPTER DUES

The portion of Chapter Dues that constitutes International Dues will be paid to International no later than February 15th.

The payment of one-year dues shall accompany all applications for membership. The Annual dues for all member categories: Active, Associate, Charter, Life Members and Social members will be \$25.00. The dues may however be changed for the next ensuing year and thereafter at the will of the chapter by a vote at a regularly scheduled meeting. Dues shall be due on or before the Annual Meeting each year.

All selected members owing annual dues by February 1st shall be notified by the Secretary.

All selected Members whose dues remain unpaid through the first quarter of the renewing year will stand suspended, and cease to enjoy the privileges of the Chapter until current dues are paid, and the member is properly reinstated. If the dues are not paid by the end of the first quarter of the renewing year, the delinquent member will be dropped from the membership roster.

ARTICLE: 4: CHAPTER DUES, FUNDS, CONTRIBUTIONS

SECTION 4-2 Fund Raising

All funds shall be raised by fees, dues; activities, donations and such other means as the Chapter shall from time to time deem necessary staying within guidelines of good taste and lawful activities.

All funds exceeding normal operating expenses shall be deposited in a federally insured checking and / or savings account and withdrawn as deemed necessary. No debts shall be incurred by or for the Chapter except as authorized by a vote by the membership present at a regular meeting of the Chapter, with the exception of the Secretary and Treasurer who is authorized to contract for expenses such as postage, stationary, printing, newsletters, etc.

The Executive Board of the Chapter may, without objection, spend up to \$250 without the vote of the membership if such expense cannot reasonably be delayed until the next regularly scheduled chapter meeting. However, all expenditures shall be reported at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the chapter.

SECTION 4-3: GUIDELINE FOR CONTRIBUTIONS

Approved by the Board of Directors and the Chapter Membership whereby, upon the severe injury, illness or death of a fire fighter, or other emergency service related personnel, a contribution of up to fifty dollars (\$50.00) would be given to the family, provided that the department or agency where the injury, severe illness or loss of life occurred has an active or social member in good standing within the Red Knights NY Chapter # 22 current Roster of Membership.

Contributions for direct family members of a Red Knights NY Chapter # 22 member in good standing of up to seventy-five (\$75.00) would be given in the event of illness, severe injury, or death. Direct family shall be defined and limited to husband, wife, partner, significant other, children, step-children and parents.

ARTICLE: 4: CHAPTER DUES, FUNDS, AND CONTRIBUTIONS

SECTION 4-3: GUIDELINE FOR CONTRIBUTIONS (continued)

Contributions to the family of an *Active Member* of Red Knights NY Chapter # 22 member in good standing of up to two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) would be given in the event of severe injury or death, unless the active member died while participating in a Chapter sanctioned event, whereby the contribution would not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00), and that the illness, injury and / or death is not the result of illegal activity. The said amount would be decided on a case by case basis by the membership with a recommendation from the Board of Directors.

Any member in good standing may approach and / or solicit individual members at a monthly meeting to seek contributions to be donated to any event, cause, family, or individual, but such funds are separate and distinct from the Chapter Treasury and does not infer nor obligate a donation from the Chapter.

The caveat of *good standing* shall be defined as any member classification that has his and / or her dues paid for the current year and is not on suspension at the time of the request.

This **Guideline for Contributions** is to be perceived as intended, to be a guideline only, and does not guarantee, warrant, nor imply, that any such contributions(s) would be given.

CHAPTER ADMENDMENTS

ARTICLE: 5: DISSOLUTION, DISBANDING, CHANGES TO BYLAWS

SECTION 5-1: CHAPTER BEING DISSOLVED OR DISBANDED

If the Chapter is dissolved or disbanded for any reason, any remaining funds will be donated to a charity by a majority vote of the remaining membership.

SECTION 5-2: REVERTING TO INTERNATIONAL CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

All other ARTICLES and SECTIONS not covered herein shall revert back the International Constitution and Bylaws.

SECTION 5-3: VOTES TO CHANGE THE CONSTITUTION

This Constitution can only be changed by a 2/3 vote of voting members present at an Annual Meeting giving thirty (30) days notice.

The Bylaw can be changed by a majority vote at any regularly scheduled meeting giving thirty (30) days prior notice.
